KEY CARDS CHANGING

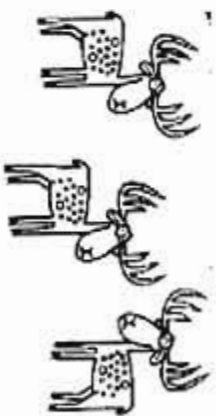
