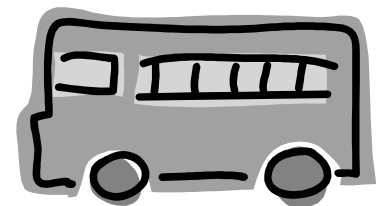
Congratulations to Rich Burgess on becoming our new President and to Jill Sprowl on becoming our new Vice president.
