AS AMMENDED AND ADOPTED BY THE HOUSE COMMITTEE

8/3/06

1. LANGUAGE

- : NO OFFENSIVE LANGUAGE IS PERMITTED**
- : NO PROFANITY IS PERMITTED**
- : LOUD DISCUSSION BETWEEN TWO OR MORE PEOPLE IS DISCOURAGED**

2. DRESS CODE

- : ACCEPTABLE ITEMS OF CLOTHING**
 - : SHORTS OF PROPER LENGTH**
 - : HATS (EXCEPT IF POSTED BY THE HOUSE COMMITTEE)**
 - : SHOES MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES**
 - : SPORTS, KNIT, & REGULAR SHIRTS**
 - : T-SHIRTS (WITHOUT OFFENSIVE LOGOS OR SAYINGS)**
 - : DRESSES, SUITS, SPLIT SKIRTS**
- : UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS OF CLOTHING**
 - : TOPS, HATS OR ANY OTHER ITEM OF CLOTHING WITH OBSCENE LANGUAGE OR DESIGN**

3. CHILDREN

- : CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 16 ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE SOCIAL QUARTERS AFTER 10:00 PM UNLESS IT IS A FAMILY NIGHT, OR AN APPROVED FAMILY ACTIVITY OR ON A SPECIAL OCCASION.**
- : NO CHILDREN ARE PERMITTED, UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN. MINORS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO BE SEATED AT THE BAR ANYTIME AND ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENT.**

4. GUESTS

- : ALL GUESTS, MUST SIGN THE GUEST BOOK. THEY ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE MEMBER AND ARE NOT ALLOWED TO MAKE ANY TYPE OF PURCHASE.**
- : IF THE MEMBER LEAVES, IT IS HIS/HER RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE SURE THAT THEIR GUEST LEAVES WITH HIM/HER.**
- : IF A GUEST AT ANY TIME DOES NOT FOLLOW OUR RULES AND REGULATIONS, THE MEMBER WILL BE ASKED TO HAVE HIS/HER GUEST LEAVE.**
